BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Bolton Central School District ("School District") hereby approves the Memorandum of Agreement ("Agreement") between the Bolton Central School District and the Bolton Fire District ("Fire District"), related to the transfer of surplus and remote land owned by the School District as represented on a plan entitled "Conceptual Layout B dated prepared by STUDIO A Landscape Architecture DPC" dated February 8, 2019, from the School District to the Fire District, and authorizes the Superintendent to execute the Agreement, deed and any required papers to effectuate such transfer on the School District's behalf. As the Fire District serves the same community as the School District, there shall be no cost to the Fire District for the transfer, except that the Fire District will pay the any costs associated with recording the deed and surveying the property. **VOTE: ALL FAVORABLE MOTION: CARRIED**

E. **MOTION** by Mrs. Quigan, seconded by Mrs. Johnson, that the Board of Education approve a Resolution to Establish a Retirement Contribution Reserve Fund and a Retirement Contribution Reserve Sub-Fund, as presented.

WHEREAS, as a part of the 2019 – 2020 Budget Legislation, New York State has amended certain provisions of section 6-r of the General Municipal Law, relating to Retirement Contribution Reserve Funds; and

WHEREAS, as amended, section 6-r of the General Municipal Law allows a school board to establish a reserve fund to be known as the Retirement Contribution Reserve Fund ("RCRF") and Sub-Fund to be used for the purpose of financing retirement contributions, and/or to finance appropriations authorized by law to offset all or a portion of the amount deducted from the moneys apportioned to the school district from the state for the support of common schools; and

WHEREAS, "retirement contribution" is defined as all or any portion of the amount payable by a school district to the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System ("ERS") or the New York State Teachers' Retirement System ("TRS") pursuant to Education Law section 521; and

WHEREAS, if a school board establishes an RCRF pursuant to section 6-r of the General Municipal Law, for the purpose of financing retirement contributions to the ERS, it may also create a "sub-fund" within the RCRF, which is to be separately administered, for the purpose of financing retirement contributions to the New York State Teachers' Retirement System

C. Shippee Addendum

Creation of Retirement Contribution reserve and Sub-Reserve Funds and/or to finance appropriations authorized by law to offset all or a portion of the amount deducted from the moneys apportioned to the school district from the state for the support of the common schools; and

WHEREAS, the Bolton Central School District Board of Education desires to establish a Retirement Contribution Reserve Fund and Retirement Contribution Reserve Sub-Fund for such purposes;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED: The Bolton Central School District hereby establishes a fund to be known as the Retirement Contribution Reserve Fund ("RCRF"), as well as a sub-fund to be known as the Retirement Contribution Reserve Sub-Fund ("RCRS"), to be separately administered within the RCRF, effective immediately, to be funded from the available fund balance from the 2018 – 2019 school year and additional contributions from future budgetary appropriations or raised by taxes; or from such revenues as are not required by law to be paid into any other fund or account; or transfers from other reserve funds as permitted by law, to be used in accordance with applicable laws for the purpose of paying retirement contributions to the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System or the New York State Teachers' Retirement System.
