- 6. Mr. Graney thanked everyone for working together so well during this challenging time, in order to best serve our students and their families.
- 7. Mr. Graney also thanked the Board of Education for their support and faith in the Bolton Central School Administration.

There was some discussion on the logistics and expectations of students. The status of State testing was discussed but there is still indecision from NYSED and a waiver will need to be submitted by the district. This is a constantly changing situation and the district will continue to keep the safety of students, staff and community at the center of all decisions.
