## B. Presentation of the Bolton Central School Reopening Plan

The Administration discussed the plan that is currently on the District website. Additional Parent forums will be held on Tuesday, August 25<sup>th</sup> will Thursday August 27<sup>th</sup>. A Staff Forum will be held on Monday, August 24th.

The District Reopening Plan was submitted to New York state on Wednesday, July 29th. A user friendly document entitled 2020 – 2021 Reopening – Daily Routine and Frequently Asked Questions is also on the website and has been emailed to parents.

Mr. Graney and Mr. Shippee reviewed the entire 2020 -2021 Reopening – Daily Routine and Frequently Asked Questions document section by section; from the general percautions covering social distancing, cleaning, temperature checks, health screenings and visitors and walked through the routine of a normal day at Bolton Central School for all staff and students.

Kathy Pfau thanked the committee for all their hard work for making the decision to offer parents and students the flexibility of making theeir decisions between in person or remote learning for an academic quarter at a time.

Mr. Foy praised the hard work of everyone involved.

The Bolton rate is a \$ -.82 or **15.07% decrease** over 2019-2020 rate.
