- A. Facilities Committee- Mr. Schoder reported that the Facilities Committee met on Wednesday, October 7th. During this meeting the committee discussed the new batting cages that are nearing completion on the north end of the upper field, east of the softball field.

In reviewing the progress of the installation of the oil water separator, it was discussed that the project is pending a monitoring plan. Within the last

week a plan has been developed and implemented. Bolton Central School has sent a letter of completion to the Town of Bolton as well as an invitation for a site visit.

The building condition survey is due to the State Education Department by January 15, 2016. The District will use the report as a basis for any potential development of a capital improvement project should it become necessary. The report is pending from AES Northeast at this time.

The Town of Bolton appears to be making progress with the amount of fill being transported to the Town Recreation field. Department of Environmental Conservation coordination is still pending at this time. The committee will provide more information as it becomes available.

The next meeting of the Facilities Committee will be scheduled once a draft of the building condition survey is available for review.
