Whereas, the Bolton Central School District Superintendent received a letter dated January 27, 2012, from NYSUT requesting that the Board of Education recognize the Bolton Support Personnel Association, a newly created unit affiliated with NYSUT/AFT/NEA/AFL-CIO as the exclusive representative for district employees in a negotiating unit comprised of certain titles ("Unit");

Whereas, the Board of Education has been informed by NYSUT representatives that a majority of the employees in the proposed Unit have authorized the Bolton Support Personnel Association, NYSUT/AFT/NEA/AFL-CIO, to act as their exclusive representative; and

Whereas, the Board of Education has reviewed and discussed the recognition of the Unit; and

Whereas, the Board of Education is in support of recognizing the newly created Unit.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Board of Education of the Bolton Central School District does hereby voluntarily recognize the Bolton Support Personnel Association, a newly created affiliated with NYSUT/AFT/NEA/AFL-CIO, as the exclusive representative for district employees in a negotiating unit to be comprised of the following titles: Bus Driver; Cleaner; Custodian; Food Service Helper; Mechanic; Receptionist; Teacher Aide; Typist; and

Be it Further Resolved, that the Board of Education does hereby specifically exclude from the newly created Unit the following titles: Cook/Manager; Transportation Supervisor/Mechanic; Building Maintenance Mechanic; Clerk of the Board; Secretary to the Superintendent; Account Clerk; Tax Collector; and Deputy District Treasurer.
