- B. 2013-2014 budget discussion. Ms. Dennin reported that staff requisitions have been collected. The Governor's budget proposal shows a \$125,000 decrease in State Aid for our school.
- C. **MOTION** by Mr. Gabriels, seconded by Mrs. Peterson that the Board of Education approve the creation of a new job classification, as per Warren County Bureau of Civil Service, entitled Bus Driver/Maintenance Worker. VOTE: ALL FAVORABLE. MOTION CARRIED.
- D. **MOTION** by Mr. Gabriels, seconded by Mr. Schoder that the Board of Education change the Civil Service job classification category for Mr. Patrick Ross from Bus Driver/Cleaner to Bus Driver/Maintenance Worker, effective March 1, 2013. Salary contingent upon negotiation with the BSPA; will initially be \$ 26,140.
