Town of Bolton	\$5.3649	per thousand assessed valuation
Town of Hague	\$6.4237	per thousand assessed valuation
Town of Horicon	\$4.8820	per thousand assessed valuation

The Bolton rate is a \$.06 or 1.05% increase over 2017-2018 rate.

Recommend the Board of Education approves the establishment of standard work days for its employees and will report days worked to the New York State and Local Employees’ Retirement System based on the time-keeping system or the record of activities maintained and submitted by these members to the clerk of this body, as presented.
