We need to start planning now and booking our flights as soon as we are able. The overall cost for the week will be \$2500 per student. This will include all travel expenses, campground and park fees, admissions to the aquarium in Monterey and Hearst Castle as well as kayaking fees and ride bracelets for the Santa Cruz Boardwalk! Additionally, 21 meals will be provided during the week-long adventure.

This trip is currently open to students who will be in High School during 2023-2024. Priority will be given to 10th, 11th, & 12th graders, but we hope all interested will be able to attend.

We need to sign the contract and commit to this trip by the end of May 2023, so an initial deposit of \$300 per person will be due by Monday, May 15th. Following that, we will set up a payment plan calendar so that all monies can be collected by Christmas.
