A. Legislative – No report this month

- B. Employee Relations Mr. Murphy reported on a committee meeting held on Tuesday, January 5 with representatives of the BCSTA. Discussion included enrollment trends and staffing. It was decided that the entire board will meet with representatives of the BCSTA on Monday, January 25th
- C. Facilities Mr. Ciccarelli and Ms. Dennin met with architect Richard E. Jones regarding the bus garage and would like to meet with the Facilities Committee for further discussion. The clerk will contact Mrs. Bennett and will attempt to set a meeting date.

6. <u>INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM</u>

- A. **MOTION** by Mrs. Persons, seconded by Mrs. Quigan that the Board of Education grant a tenure appointment, in the tenure area of School Nurse D. DiPietro Teacher to Mrs. Donna DiPietro, effective February 1,2010. Mrs. DiPietro is currently assigned to the position of Grades PK-12 School Nurse Teacher **VOTE: ALL FAVORABLE. MOTION CARRIED.**
- B. Race to the Top Initiative Mr. Ciccarelli explained the "Race to the Top" initiative which is a Federal \$700 million grant that States can apply for. At this point 612 out of 707 schools in New York State have applied and now it is up to the State Legislature to make application for the State. Mr. Murphy asked for a copy of the Memo of Understanding that Bolton Central School filed.
- C. Discussion of enrollment projections as they pertain to extra and co-curricular programs. Mr. Ciccarelli handed out an information sheet on the enrollment and extra/co-curricular and athletic teams minimum enrollments. There was a long discussion amongst the board and community members in attendance about the future of our district and the possibility of sharing services with other neighboring districts. Topics of discussion included: declining number of participants for athletic teams, pattern of the last 10 years enrollments, school website, ways to entice people to move to Bolton, promotion of our school district.

The board will meet with representatives of the Teacher's Association on January 25 at 6:30 PM to discuss this further.

Mr. Murphy asked how many substitute drivers we have now – Answer - 3 - including Mr. Bandel Mr. Murphy asked several other questions about the number of substitute bus drivers.

C. **MOTION** by Mrs. Quigan, seconded by Mrs. Persosn that the Board of Education approve the posting of vacancy for Cleaner/Bus Driver position, Posting effective January 12, 2010 through February 5, 2010. **VOTE: ALL FAVORABLE. MOTION CARRIED.**

8. PUBLIC COMMENT

A. Mrs. Lori Jordon commented about basketball players sloppy appearances after games, particularly at the modified level.

After Mrs. Jordan's comments, Mr. Murphy asked about the Code of Conduct and also asked Mr. Ciccarelli to write a memo to coaches to reiterate the district's expectations for student athletes.

- B. Mrs. Peg Reilly asked why the national anthem and players lineups were not being played at home basketball games. Mr. Ciccarelli reported that the PA system has not been working properly but is scheduled to be repaired this week.
- C. Mr. Chet McNulty said he has trouble hearing board discussion and suggested the board use a sound system. He also thanked Mr. Ciccarelli for selling basketball jerseys.
